Tracking

Tracking records your path. When you start tracking, your device logs your location and updates the track line at the specified log interval. Note: Tracking may incur additional costs when not on a plan with unlimited tracking.



Note: If you have MapShare enabled, you can share your location through MapShare from the Tracking screen when you start tracking, or at any time by selecting Share

Navigation

You can navigate along a route or to a waypoint on your inReach device.

A route is a sequence of locations that leads you to your final destination. Routes are created on your Garmin Explore account.

Syncing
